City Council Ward I Vacancy

Mike Crawford resigns due to health reasons

The La Vista City Council accepted the resignation last night of City Councilmember Mike Crawford from his Ward I seat effective immediately.

Crawford, last elected in 2020, has served on the City Council since 2008, and served previously from 1980 to 1984. Crawford has resigned due to health reasons.

"It was an honor to serve with Mike, he is a dedicated public servant," said Mayor Douglas Kindig. "Our thoughts and prayers are with Mike and his family as he navigates these health issues."

At its meeting last night, the City Council declared a vacancy for the Ward I seat and Mayor Kindig will make a recommendation for a replacement to the City Council by April 5. The term of this vacancy runs through December 2024.
