Current Programs

Youth Coed Volleyball We have currently played 3 games of an 8 game season. We have two 3rd/4th grade teams and two 5th/6th grade teams. We are partnered with BJSA again this year.

Adult Women's Fall Volleyball is currently on game 8 of a 12 game season.

Winter Programs

Adult Women's Winter Volleyball: Registration started on November 1 and will run through Dec 16 or until the league is full with 8 teams. If we have enough interest, we will look at expanding the league to 12-16 teams.

Youth Basketball League: Early bird registration ended on November 11th with the final registration deadline being November 25th. Practices will begin during the 2nd or 3rd week of December with games beginning in January. We are partnered with PRO again this season.

Youth Coed Basketball Clinic: Registration runs through Dec 30th. This clinic is for 1st & 2nd graders and will be held on Saturday mornings starting on January 13th and will run for 5 consecutive Saturdays. Clinics will be conducted by volunteers from the LVPD again this year.

RoundBall Reindeer Shootout: The 3rd annual Free Throw Shooting Contest will be held December 2nd for boys and girls in Kdg. through 8th grade. This free event is for children & their parent/guardian or grandparent to compete together as a team. Each team member will shoot 15 free throws and the winner will be determined based on the combined total for each grade and each division.

Spring Programs

Registration will begin December 1st for 2018 Spring Baseball, Softball, Flag Football and Soccer. These sports seasons will begin in April.
