SYNOPSIS

A resolution has been prepared to authorize The National Research Center at Polco, Middleton, Wisconsin, to administer the National Community Survey (NCS) and provide subsequent analysis and reports in an amount not to exceed \$19,800.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FY23/FY24 Biennial Budget provides funding for this survey.

RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND

Integral to the City's strategic planning process, the National Community Survey allows City leaders to assess the satisfaction of residents as it relates to core municipal services. The collected data will help inform decisions on programming, budgeting and capital allocation, and community engagement.

Previously, the City conducted NCS surveys in 2008, 2013, 2016 and 2019. If approved, staff will begin working with the NRC at Polco immediately to prepare all materials and it is anticipated the data collection would begin in early January with a final report to Council in early April.
