### **SPECIAL EVENTS**

The Papillion La Vista School Districts Annual Volleyball League has over 100 teachers and school employees playing volleyball on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons in our Community Center. The League runs from late February through May.

An AED (Automated External Defibrillator) was placed in the Community Center in late February. An AED is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the potentially life threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and ventricular tachycardia in a patient, and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electrical therapy which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm. AED's are not designed to shock asystole ('flat line' patterns). AED's are designed to be used by laypersons who ideally should have received AED training.

**CURRENT MONTHLY ACTIVITIES AND UPDATES:**




